



Visitation rules and regulations

- Residents who have completed phase I and who are in good standing will be allowed to have one Saturday visit while they are at BCRC
- No Overnight visits are allowed
- Residents are only permitted to go on visitation with immediate family members that have been approved by staff and are not permitted to visit with friends or girlfriends at any time
- Visitation takes place on Saturdays only
- Pickup time cannot be any earlier than 9am Saturday morning
- Resident is to be dropped off no later than 7pm Saturday night
- Resident is not permitted to be unsupervised at any time during the visit and must remain with the immediate family member they left with.
- Resident is not permitted to use the telephone or computer to contact anyone who is not an immediate family member while on visitation
- Visitation should be planned one week in advance and is not to interfere with any program scheduling
- Any resident will not be permitted more than 1 visit
- Absolutely no drug or alcohol use will be tolerated. Drug test will be administered on return from visit and any positive test result will result in dismissal from program.
- Resident will be required to submit to a drug and alcohol analysis upon return
- Any items brought back with any resident must be turned into staff
- Do not return with secular music or movies that are rated "R"
- Violation of any rule will result in forfeiture of privileges or possible dismissal from the program
- Tobacco use is prohibited during family visitation. Staff may administer a nicotine detection test at their discretion. Testing positive for nicotine will result in a infraction against residents stay.
