



## **Current Volunteer Opportunities for the Rose House** (Summer 2022)

**We are so excited about your willingness to come alongside the Rose House to share your gifts and the love of Christ!**

A little about us.. Christian Recovery Centers Inc is a residential, nonprofit Treatment Center specializing in helping those voluntarily seeking assistance for a substance abuse issue.

CRCI provides its services at no cost to the individual or their families. The program is designed to assist those struggling with substance abuse issues by providing a comprehensive, multi-faceted treatment curriculum as well as fully meeting the residents' daily needs.

CRCI operates some of the only programs in the Carolinas offering a faith based 12-step curriculum with professional therapy services, as well as traditional education opportunities for all residents and intern staff. The goal is that every resident would be able to use CRCI as a springboard experience into their new successful life.

**Below you will find our current list of volunteer opportunities. Please keep in mind that serving does not mean you need to have a certain skill set, we offer opportunities to send cards of encouragement, share fellowship at lunch, join us on a field trip etc. Knowing someone cares enough to be a part of their lives is a huge blessing.**

**Weekend Warrior Project** – This program is for those that desire to spend a whole day with ladies on a Saturday or Sunday. You will have the ability to plan activities for the residents on or off campus. If the residents will be off campus for lunch, beach, park, etc. lunch should be brought with the group (they can make sandwiches) or donated by your organization. Ideas for off-campus activities: movies, putt putt, bowling (if you can't sponsor, we can provide \$5 each for 3 games & rental), visiting your church for a service, event, or community service project or assisting with your food pantry. Feel free to propose other options for approval through the Director. With special approval, a weekend getaway or retreat would also be an option if proper supervision with staff members is available. (for example: the women have been sponsored to attend The Women of Joy Conference in Myrtle Beach 2022, and also were blessed with a vrbo weekend trip to Charlotte and visited the Billy Graham Library & attended Elevation Worship service on Sunday Morning.

**Fellowship with the residents (Friday night, Saturday or Sunday)** Come host any number of hours to play a game with the ladies, (we have a closet full, but feel free to bring your own), go out to dinner, go for a long walk, take a trip to the library, a park or share a skill (knitting, crochet, gardening, painting, scrapbooking, stamping, jewelry making, community service crafts etc.)

We have a cornhole for outdoor fun, and a firepit. Residents love watching movies (G or pg-13 not violent or with foul language) and If you are gifted with an instrument, the women love to worship!

**Volunteer Drivers** – This is a priority need. This would keep our program running smoothly & more efficiently by not utilizing a needed staff member. As a volunteer, driving a resident to an appointment provides help in this area as well as being able to be a witness for Jesus.

**Prayers!** We appreciate your prayers for our organization and our residents, both male and female.

**Program Volunteer** – Our programming runs from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm Monday – Friday. Weekends include community service projects, off-site activities, sharing time with visitors and church.

1. **Provide a Meal:** Monday – Sunday - Volunteer to come in and cook OR drop off food for breakfast, lunch, dinner or dessert!
2. **Chapel Speaker** – 9:00-10:00 – We would love you to share a lesson on God's word.
3. **Speaker Meeting** –10:30 – 11:30 This portion of the program is designed for either testimonies (how has God worked in your life to bring you where you are in your current job, ministry, etc.) or specific subject teachings (health, nutrition, self care, social etiquette, codependency, recovery techniques, communication, biblical truths, life skills, career development. As an example, classes have been given on sign language, Bait of Satan & crazy love bible study, time management, resume building as well as many others.
4. **Lunch 11:30-12:30** - What a great way to get to know the women of the Rose House! Can you and/or your group join us for lunch? Our last class is over at 11:30, we would love for you to come join us!
5. **Life Recovery Class** – 12:45 – 1:15 A biblical guide through the 12 Steps – Here, a volunteer could supervise in a classroom environment, while the residents navigate their way independently through the bible & guided questions in their workbooks. Being present in any of our classes allows our staff additional time to support the residents and the program behind the scenes.
6. **12 Step Small Group** – 1:30-2:45 The core of our program, where residents sit together in a more relaxed location (living room, outdoors on the couch, at a park close by) and take turns reading the questions and sharing about their journey in addiction. After everyone has shared, fellow residents share insights, and staff or a volunteer can speak into the situations with God's truth and encouragement. (Experience with a 12 step is preferred for this class).
7. **Projects: 3:30-4:30** – A time where residents learn skills as they care for the home and property where they live. Join us as we paint, stain, clean windows, organize closets, kitchen cabinets, and refrigerators, yard work, etc.
8. **Resident Supervision** - Assist our staff and bless the residents as you walk alongside them by supervising the residents, taking attendance and taking notes from the speaker in one or more of our classes.
9. **Case Work** – for those that love to organize files, make copies, phone calls, and run errands! Participate by assisting our staff on-site for any number of hours, It would be such a blessing!
10. **Spiritual Check up Meetings (Pastoral Council sessions)** - 45 minute sessions 1 on 1 providing godly encouragement and council.

11. **Additional opportunities:** Volunteer coordinator, Resident Intake coordinators (Meet with our Day 1 new residents, assist with check-in and helping our new Rose Buds get settled in their new space, Resident Exit Strategy Coordinators - Will you meet with our residents prior to graduation and help support them in planning for the future? Using our exit strategy calendar, you can help them follow through with the tasks assigned to ensure a successful transition.
12. **Kitchen volunteer**, help prepare, plan and prep meals. Any number of days or hrs!
13. **Volunteer to be the Rose House Coordinator for your church or organization.** This position would be the go-to for the Rose house communication of items needed.

**Can we bring the women gifts?** We would ask that you refrain from bringing gifts with you when you volunteer. Many of the women have struggles and triggers that you may not be aware of. If you have something in mind, please contact our Director, Monique Holenko at (910-398-1554).
