LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE

The Leadership Development Initiative (LDI) is a program designed by CRCI to provide a direct path forward for exceptional residents who wish to begin a career in the field of Addiction Recovery. This program is a 1-year commitment that residents may apply for once they have successfully completed the first three phases of the inpatient recovery program. LDI participants will be provided in-depth training in the exact services that have assisted them as residents, and they will learn how to facilitate this type of intensive recovery environment as they move forward as leaders. Educational opportunities and professional certifications will be provided to each LDI participant at no cost through our partnerships with Brunswick Community College, Brunswick Literacy Council, and Peer Recovery Resources. Any person who completes this advanced training program will have the opportunity to apply for a full time staff position at Christian Recovery Centers Inc. to practically apply their experience and education as a legitimate professional.


