REQUIREMENTS

- Residents must be personally willing to enter the program, including court ordered participants.
- Residents must willingly comply with all program guidelines. CRCl is not a lock and key facility, and participants may discharge themselves at any time.
- Residents must be in good physical health (sit, stand, walk without assistance) CRCI is not a medical facility and cannot store, prescribe, or distribute prescription drugs.
- Residents must be free to travel across state lines without restrictions (parole/ probation officers are generally willing to work with us and provide travel permits to residents in the program with prior approval).
- No mood- or mind-altering substances are permitted on CRCI campuses (including antidepressants, anti-psychotics, pain killers, sleep aids, etc.). This includes both prescription and OTC medications.
- Due to zoning and program activities CRCI is not permitted to accept sex offenders.
- Nicotine-free program
- Residents must be willing to shave their face and trim their hair to a suitable length as determined by staff upon entry and at any time as required for program participation.
- Contact is limited to immediate family (wife, husband, mother, father, siblings, children) for all residents for the duration of the program.
