REQUIREMENTS

Physical Health

Residents must be able to sit, stand, walk without assistance.

Travel

Residents must be free to travel across state lines without restrictions (parole/ probation officers are generally willing to work with us and provide travel permits to residents in the program with prior approval).

Medications

Mood or mind-altering substances are not permitted on **CRCI** campuses (including antidepressants, anti-psychotics, pain killers, sleep aids, etc.). This includes both prescription and over the counter medications.

Sex Offenders

Due to zoning and program activities **CRCI** is not permitted to accept sex offenders.

Nicotine Free Program

Limited Contact

Contact is limited to immediate family (wife, husband, mother, father, siblings, children) for all residents for the duration of the program.

RESIDENTIAL RECOVERY PROGRAM

5-7 month process through Motivational Track and Phases 1-3. The initial Motivational Track phase helps residents adjust to a structured schedule while allowing time for rest and healing. Subsequent phases focus on spiritual and emotional growth, with evaluations guiding progression and leadership.

PHASE 4 RE-ENTRY PROGRAM

Our Phase 4 Re-entry Program supports a seamless transition from the intensive **Christian Recovery Center** program, providing up to 18 months of care. **CRCI** teaches residents that a life of sobriety can coexist with productivity through peer role modeling, counseling, and a supportive recovery environment.

Two pathways:

1. Social Enterprise Technician trade pathway that provides immediate employment opportunities within our enterprises.
2. Leadership Development Initiative (LDI) career pathway that focuses on training to develop future leaders of the **Christian Recovery Centers** program.
