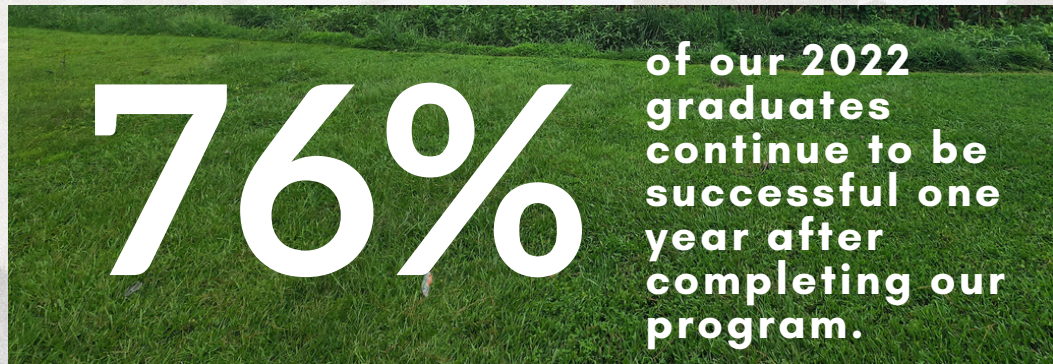

INCREASE OF OCCUPANCY

One of the not so obvious measures for success that Christian Recovery Centers considers impactful is how well we are able to increase services that would not only expand occupancy but would be able to create additional opportunities for current and future residents. In 2020, CRCI served 14 residents, and in just three years, we've expanded our capacity to accommodate 174 residents in 2023. This increase in occupancy has allowed us to provide more individuals with life-changing services and create additional

opportunities for their recovery. We're grateful for the trust our community has placed in us, and we're determined to continue offering compassionate care and proven programs. To meet the growing demand, we've enhanced our facilities, added resources, and expanded our programs to address the unique needs of each resident. Our commitment to expanding opportunities for transformation drives us forward as we continue on the mission of 'saving lives and saving souls.'



PHASE 4:

The Phase 4 program is designed to provide an additional 18 months of comprehensive care for our residents who have successfully graduated from the 6-month residential recovery program. This innovative extension goes beyond offering housing support; it encompasses a wide range of vital services to ensure a successful reentry into society while addressing the unique challenges faced by individuals transitioning from a life of addiction.

Phase 4 offers residents ongoing care and support in various crucial areas. We provide transportation assistance, ensuring they have access to essential resources and services. Nutritious food options are available to promote their physical well-being. We connect them with comprehensive health and dental resources, prioritizing their overall wellness. Our dedicated team of therapists and counselors offer therapeutic and counseling services tailored to their specific needs, fostering emotional healing and personal growth. Additionally, through our partnership with Brunswick Community College, residents have the opportunity for educational advancement, empowering them to pursue a successful future.

FINANCIAL LITERACY:

Recognizing the importance of financial literacy, we have incorporated an essential component into our Phase 4 program. With the support of United Bank in Shallotte, each resident in our Christian Recovery Centers program can open their own checking account and receive a credit card. During their stay, residents receive personalized coaching on how to effectively manage these financial tools, empowering them with the knowledge and skills to build a solid foundation for their future.

WOMEN'S LIFE CENTER:

In collaboration with Stand Against Trafficking USA, we proudly present the Women's Life Center, an initiative born from the realization of the urgent need to support women who have not only battled substance abuse but also survived the exploitation of their bodies. In response to the alarming rise in trafficking victims, the Women's Life Center aims to guide women through their journey from victim to survivor, both within our residential services and the broader community. This program provides support prior to entry at CRCI and extends beyond completion, ensuring their ongoing well-being. While temporarily housed at the Ash campus, the Women's Life Center will eventually find its permanent home in Shallotte, solidifying its impact in empowering women to reclaim their lives.

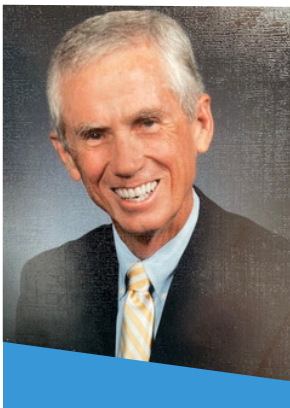


Laura Trueman
