Overview

Christian Recovery Centers, Inc (CRCI) was established in 2012 to provide residential Substance Use Disorder Recovery Services for men at no cost. Initially offering a 90-day residential program based on a peer-mentored 12-step process, CRCI now provides up to 24 months of care with 160 recovery beds for both men and women.

INCREASE OF SERVICES

Christian Recovery Centers has significantly expanded its capacity over the past three years, growing from serving 14 residents in 2020 to accommodating 160 residents in 2023. This expansion has enabled us to offer life-changing services to more individuals and create additional opportunities for recovery. We are grateful for the community's trust and remain committed to providing compassionate care and proven programs. To meet the increasing demand, we have enhanced our facilities, added resources, and tailored our programs to meet the unique needs of each resident.



RESIDENTIAL RECOVERY PROGRAM:

5-7 month process through Motivational Track and Phases 1-3. The initial Motivational Track phase helps residents adjust to a structured schedule while allowing time for rest and healing. Subsequent phases focus on spiritual and emotional growth, with evaluations guiding progression and leadership.

BENEFITS:

Participants can earn college-level certifications, state licenses, formal degrees, or attend traditional college or seminary classes. Supportive housing, transportation, access to therapeutic services and counseling, and participation in the Workforce Redevelopment Program (WRP) are also provided.

PHASE 4/ RE-ENTRY PROGRAM:

The Phase 4 Re-entry Program facilitates a seamless transition from the intensive Christian Recovery Center program, offering up to 18 months of care. Residents learn to balance sobriety with productivity through peer role modeling, counseling, and a supportive recovery environment. Two pathways are available: the Social Enterprise Technician trade pathway for immediate employment opportunities within our enterprises, and the Leadership Development Initiative (LDI) career pathway for training future program leaders.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE LDI:

Christian Recovery Centers offers a pathway mirroring a healthy recovery journey, providing real-world examples, practical experience, training, and resume-building opportunities. The WRP helps participants fill gaps in their employment history resulting from residential recovery, preparing them to become leaders in services that aided their recovery. Our goal is to assist residents in securing meaningful employment post-program.

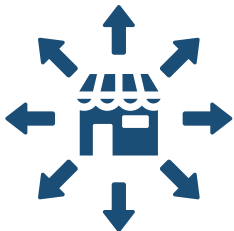

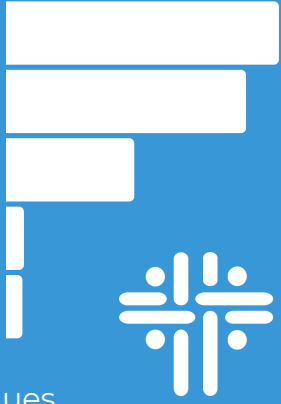
