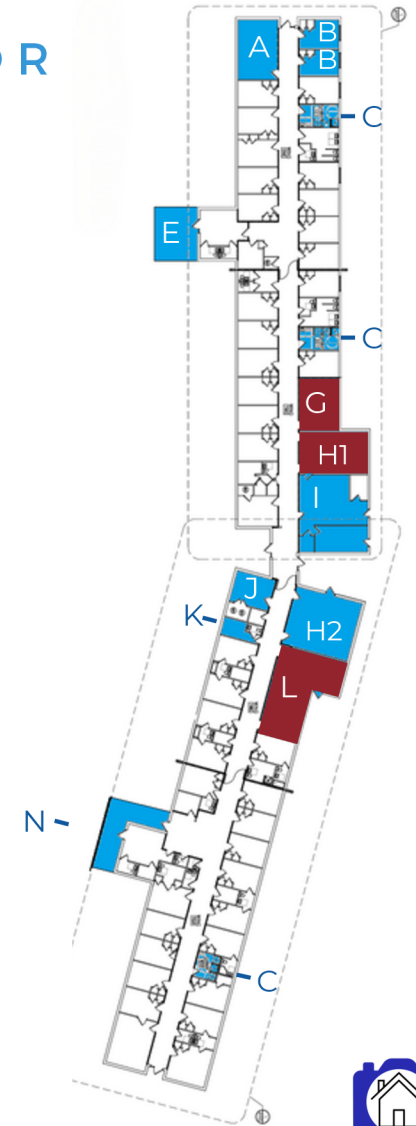

One accomplishment for which she was most proud was bringing Drug Court to Mecklenburg County; a program now mirrored across North Carolina. Both the Judge and Kenneth were advocates for men and women struggling with addiction, insisting they not be treated like criminals but instead deserve ways to manage their illnesses through established recovery programs. 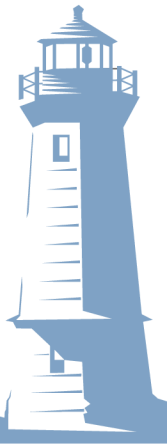

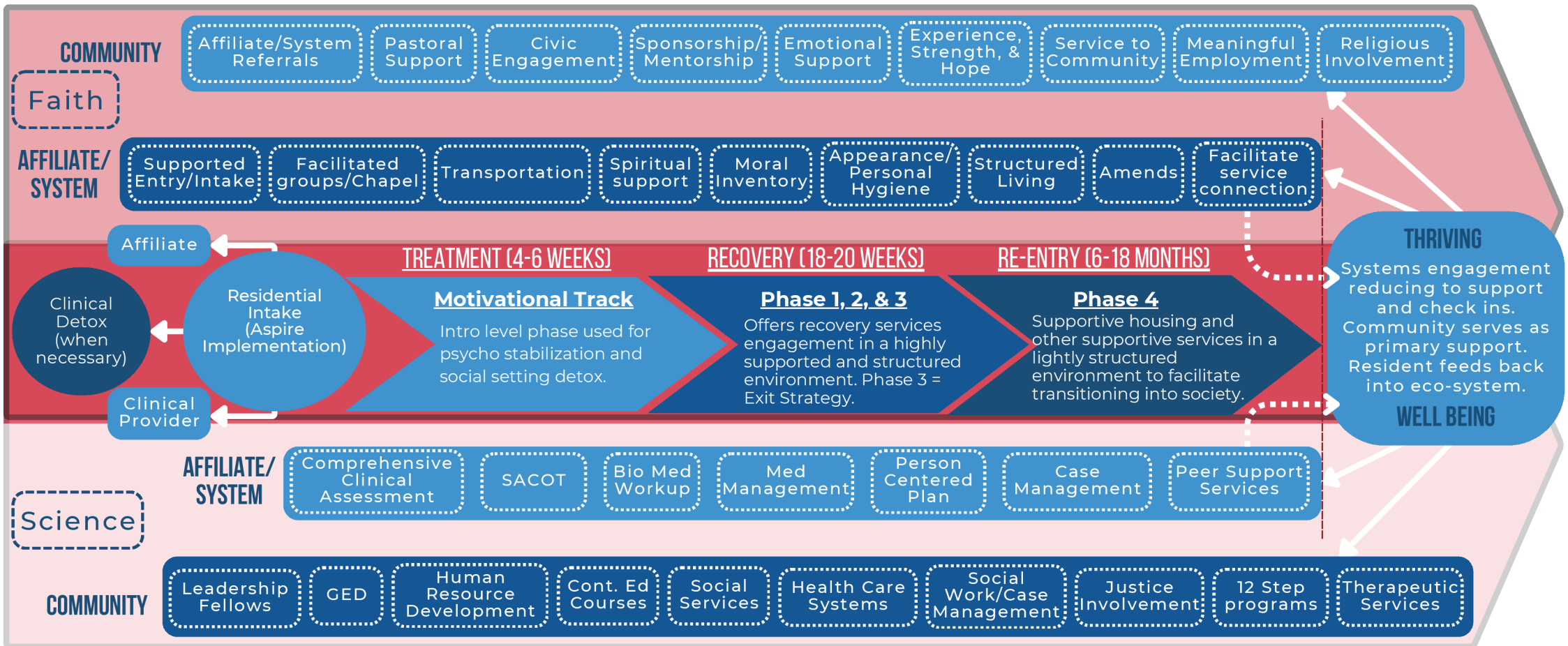
