

Our 5th annual fundraiser titled "Banding Together 4 Christian Recovery Centers" is scheduled on April 26, 2025. It will be held in the Woodlands Park in St. James from 5:00-8:00. It will include a 50/50, raffles, a silent auction item plus several great food trucks. Tickets will cost \$15. There will be no rain date.

This year's charity is a local 12 year old 501(c)3 organization. All funds raised will help them to accomplish their mission which is to provide residential substance abuse disorder recovery services for both men and women at no cost. Unfortunately, this assistance is in high demand locally and we're blessed to have them headquartered in Brunswick County. The website noted below provides a great overview. *This year's fundraising goal is \$50,000*.

We're planning for roughly 500-600 St. James residents in attendance at this live entertainment event. If reaching this audience is attractive to you, this is a great marketing opportunity. In total, our previous events have raised close to \$120,000 for Make-A-Wish, Blue Star Mothers/Stop Soldier Suicide, the St. James Service Club and the New Hope Clinic. Incidentally, the Christian Recovery Center and New Hope Clinic are close partners.

Our 2025 show will be a departure from our traditional rock music emphasis to feature the Roxboro, NC-based bluegrass band **Drive Time** and our emcee will be long-time WECT (NBC) & WSFX (FOX) news anchor **Jon Evans**.




Jon Evans Biography

He will mark his 42nd year in television news in 2025 and his 48th year in broadcasting since getting his start in radio in 1978.

He anchors "WECT News at 5:30", co-anchors "WECT News at 6pm" and "WECT News at 11pm" with Frances Weller, and co-anchors "WECT News at 10" on Fox Wilmington with Daniella Hankey.

Jon also produces and hosts the "Ion1 with Jon Evans" podcast, which is available on all major podcast apps. The podcast has won two prestigious Edward R. Murrow Awards in 2023 and 2024, along with several Best Podcast awards from the RTDNAC, since its debut in 2017.

Jon is also WECT's Political Director, leading the station's political coverage and hosting all forums and debates.



Jon joined the WECT News team as an anchor/reporter in 2008, after working at the NBC affiliate in Wilmington starting in 1992. He was named WECT's Assistant News Director in 2016. The Radio Television Digital News Association of the Carolinas has named Jon "TV News Anchor of the Year" five times (2018, 2017, 2016, 2014, 2013) in Division II.

In the community, Jon has donated his time to several service organizations as an emcee or event host, including the Autism Society of North Carolina, JDRF, American Cancer Society, Special Olympics, Communities in Schools, The Willie Stargell Foundation and many others.

In 2023, Jon received the Order of the Long Leaf Pine award, the highest civilian honor bestowed by the Office of the Governor in North Carolina, to individuals who have made significant contributions to the state through their service.

Jon and his wife Sheila, who were both born and raised in Pennsylvania, have been married since 1985. They have three adult children, Jonathan, Monica and Abby, and three grandchildren, Jack, Sam and Elliott.
