### **Second Chance Testimony**

In 2017, I came to Brunswick Christian Recovery Center for my first attempt at overcoming my heroin addiction. Those three months were eyeopening, and by the time I graduated, I had a better understanding of addiction and lifelong relationships. Afterward, I moved into a halfway house, threw myself into work, and neglected meetings and church. I convinced myself I didn't have a problem, thinking a year of sobriety proved I had it all figured out.

However, at the one-year mark, I began to slip. Occasional use turned into daily habits, and over the next five years, I spiraled back into addiction. By 2023, I hit rock bottom and found myself back at Christian Recovery Centers. The first month was filled with shame and disbelief, but the support I received helped me push through. A powerful moment came when Renee Cooper said, "If God has already forgiven you, who do you think you are that you can't forgive yourself?"

### THAT WAS MY TURNING POINT

After graduation, I joined the leadership team as an LDI, something I never imagined doing. Serving others in addiction gave me a purpose, and through guidance from my sponsor and regular meetings, I built a foundation I never had before. While it's not always easy, working with residents has filled a void that money never could. I'm incredibly grateful to God and CRCI for helping me change my life. Today, I see God using me to help change others' lives, just as David Koch says, "Addicts just want to feel that someone cares."
